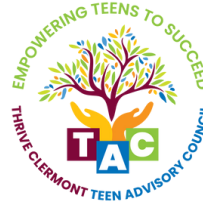

2023 THRIVE PROGRAMS



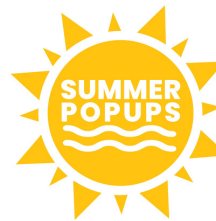
TEEN ADVISORY COUNCIL
